Questions for Reflection:

- 1. Why is it significant that sexual difference (as opposed to race or socio-economics) is the one difference created by God? Why or why not?
- 2. Do you believe gender differences are biological, socially constructed, or a combination of both? What evidence can you find to support your belief? Does it matter?
- 3. Have you harbored incorrect or unloving attitudes toward the opposite sex? If so, what were they? How will you change how you interact with the opposite sex?
- 4. If you are married: Have you ever thought about the purpose of your marriage? Brainstorm with your spouse: what would we like to say we have accomplished at the end of our lives together? What unique gifts and interests do we have to offer as a couple?
