U.S. Statistics

- The U.S. incarcerates more of its citizens than any nation in the world. (724 per 100,000, Russia is 2nd at 581)
- In 1972, there were 200,000 in prison in the U.S., today there are 2.2 million
- _____ million Americans have been incarcerated at one time.
- The U.S. has 5% of the world population, but _____% of its prisoners.

Racial Disparity in the U.S.

- Blacks represent 12% of the population but _____% of the prison population.

- The rate for white men 30-34 without a high school diploma went from 2% to 5%
